HPSF Teacher Grant FAQ

Who can apply?

Hallsville School District's certified staff can apply. Applications can be from an individual or from a collaborative effort.

Why should you apply?

If you have a creative and innovative idea that will engage your students and enhance their educational experience, but it can be not fulfilled through regular budgetary funding, please apply! Our desire is to fund grants that motivate, inspire, and enrich your students and supports you, the teacher.

What should you apply for?

Technology, programs, materials, and activities that your school budget is unable to fund. If technology is requested in your grant application, you must seek prior approval from approval from the Hallsville School District's Technology Department. All grant applications must be in line with Hallsville School District's Board of Educations Policy 1470. Please note on the application the amount of the Donor's Choose "Fulfillment Labor and Materials" and "Suggested donation to help DonorsChoose.org reach more classrooms." The total project goal must not exceed \$250.

Who do the resources belong to?

The granted resources are the property of the Hallsville School District.

How are the grants selected?

Each grant is evaluated by members of the HPSF, which is comprised of local community members. Grants will be funded using a scoring system. Due to a limited amount of funding, not all grants will be funded.

What if your grant is selected?

If your grant is selected, the HPFS will contact you directly by April 15. After accepting the grant, you will be asked to submit your grant proposal to DonorsChoose.org. Once the project is approved by them, please contact the HPSF. From there, we will fund your project using the Donor's Choose link.
